# Group Enrichment Options

### Club Scientific Grades N-8

Club Scientific's after school classes are split into two groups Nursery-Kindergarten and grades 1-8. Each week they will explore new activities and experiments in different branches of science. Activities and experiments explore the fun of biology, chemistry, paleontology, and more. Club Scientific uses carefully designed inquiry centered lessons that involve children with hands-on activities which capture children's natural curiosity, stimulate their interest in science and teach them important science topics along with critical thinkings skills. Science was never this much fun!

KidzArt Grades PreK-6

KidzArt is a weekly drawing program for kids that will leave them with more than just an appreciation for art. Their proven teaching method builds self-confidence and develops problem solving and creative thinking skills. Students embark on a creative journey to explore the many elements of visual arts. Each week students will create original drawings, while being exposed to new materials, artistic styles, and cultural interpretations. All artist quality materials are included. No prior experience is necessary. This enrichment opportunity is offered in two groups: PreK and Kindergarten and 1st through 6th grades.

Tae Kwon Do Grades K-6

Master Mechelle Smith, 6th Degree Black Belt has been teaching and training in the Korean martial art of Tae Kwon Do for over 30 years. Tae Kwon Do is an ancient martial art that combines moral values and respect with effective punching and kicking techniques. Tae Kwon Do is the most practiced martial art in the world today! Classes include warm ups, strength, and flexibility training. This is a black belt path program leading to World Tae Kwon Do Federation Certification. This course is offered to students in Kindergarten through Grade 6. Students who have taken previous classes will continue to advance their technique.

### Hip Hop Dance Grades 2-5

Open to grades 2-5. Hip hop originated from street dancing. This high energy style includes: locking, popping, house dance, break dancing, pop and electro-dance set to hip hop music. Kyle Henzler is a teacher/choreographer and set designer. Kyle has received her Level 1 and Level 2 Teacher Certification with top honors in ballet, jazz, tap, acrobatics, and modern dance through Dance Educators of America. She is a member of DEA. ### Beginner Dance Combination Class Grades N-K

Open to Nursery, PreKindergarten, and Kindergarten students. This class offers a fun introduction to ballet and tap that includes body awareness through stretching, musicality with across the floor movements, and use of props. ### Amazing Athletes Grades N-K
