Dungeons & Dragons for 7th - 10th graders.

Macrame: Discover the art of knotting Grades 4-10

Beginner level: learn 6 basic macrame knots: Square knot, alternating square knot, half not spiral sinnet, double half hitch, larks head and wrap knot. Projects will include paracord people keychain, assorted keychain patterns using cotton twine, macrame coasters and a small wall hanging using cotton cord. Students will advance at their own pace.

Sticky, Fizzy Science for N/PK

Students will love this club filled with developmentally appropriate science experiments! Using safe, every day materials, students will learn about concepts such as velocity, density, matter and more! Bring your lab coats and get ready to be a scientist! This multi-sensory Nursery/PreK club pairs movement, literacy and math to create fun activities that will have your child's entire brain working!
